Pursuant to the authority conferred by Rule 2.050(b),  
Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is

**ORDERED** that:

Five Divisions of the Circuit Court are created for  
the administration and management of Court proceedings:

- (1) Civil Division
- (2) Criminal Division
- (3) Probate & Guardianship Division
- (4) Family Division
- (5) Appellate Division

Two Divisions of the County Court for Monroe County  
are created for the administration and management of Court  
proceedings:

- (1) Civil Division
- (2) Criminal Division

Pursuant to Florida Supreme Court Opinion SC00-1410,  
this Local Rule shall be submitted to the Supreme Court for  
approval, and shall become effective on the approval date.  
Upon such approval, Local Rule 1, dated December 13,  
1994, and Administrative Order 2.049 shall be rescinded.
