WHEREAS, there is a desire on the part of the judiciary of this circuit and the Clerk of the Court to simplify and clarify procedures regarding the release of bonds in criminal cases;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED:

Pursuant to Section 903.31, Florida Statutes, a trial bond shall not guarantee the defendant's appearance after adjudication of guilt, unless the surety/bondsman has agreed in the bail contract to take responsibility for appearances after adjudication. Absent such agreement on the part of the surety/bondsman, upon adjudication the clerk shall prepare all necessary papers to release the bond.
