CASE STATUS REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR REAL PROPERTY MORTAGE FORECLOSURE CASES

WHEREAS, Florida Supreme Court Administrative Order AOSC13-15, *In Re:* Case Status Reporting Requirements for Real Property Mortgage Foreclosure Cases finds it beneficial to require the chief judge of every circuit court to issue a local administrative order establishing an effective communication mechanism by which courts and clerks are notified of status changes in real property mortgage foreclosure cases in a timely manner, and;

WHEREAS, the status of a foreclosure case and related definitions have been adopted by the Florida Supreme Court and are published in the Foreclosure Data Collection Plan promulgated by the Office of the State Courts Administrator; and

WHEREAS, Florida Supreme Court Administrative Order AOSC13-15, *In Re: Case Status Reporting Requirements for Real Property Mortgage Foreclosure Cases* further requires the chief judge of every circuit court to provide direction for designating the status of cases as active or inactive;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Clerk of Court for Monroe County and the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit is directed to comply with the requirements of the Foreclosure Initiative Data Collection Plan as promulgated by the Office of the State Courts Administrator.
- 2. When the clerk's office becomes aware of events initiating a change in the status of a case from active to inactive or inactive to active, the clerk's office shall notify the court for further review.
- 3. When the court becomes aware of events initiating a change in the status of a case, or when the clerk notifies the court of events initiating a change in the status of a case, the court shall issue an order directing the change in case status, using one of the sample orders hereby attached.

This order shall be effective on the date of execution.
